Christmas is a busy time. This checklist is designed to make sure you have all the tools & necessities through the Christmas break & until QCMS is re-open. Once you have gone through the list, check them off below

1. Service

The Most Important factor is service. Has your coffee equipment been serviced in the last 12 months? If not, it's highly recommended to get a quick general service booked before the cut off deadline. Usually we aussies won't be too happy if the machine needs a service in the middle of christmas day.

2. Cleaning

Make sure you have all the cleaning tools & consumables on hand & with enough left to cover you over the break. For automatics, this could mean milk cleaner solution, descaler or tablet cleaners. For Traditional Espresso Machines, this means espresso backwash & descaler. Brewers should also make sure they have enough filter papers or rubber stops if required.

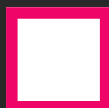
2. Coffee
